Subj: Water Service Connection Inspection

On November 18th, 2025 the Town of Schuyler Falls Board passed a resolution establishing the Sand Road Water District. As a result, Clinton County and their engineers at Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C. (B&L) are pleased to inform you that design of the waterline is now underway. Now that design has started, here are a few things that you can expect to see happening in your neighborhood over the next few months:

- Warren Ramie Surveying will be on Sand Road starting in early December 2025 to survey the road and front yards of residents for design of the watermain and services
- B&L will be scheduling visits to inspect basement pipes for connecting the municipal water to your existing plumbing. The inspections are tentatively scheduled to start the week of December 15, 2025, and must be done before construction, so please coordinate with the B&L team as follows:

 - For those without basements, the B&L team will inspect your outside water pipe locations to determine connection location.

As we start this project, the County remains committed to providing municipal water to the Sand Road residents. We ask that you let us know if you do not want to connect to the Sand Road Water District and we'll provide you with a water service up to the curb stop during construction. Please understand that if you decide to connect at a later time, then the cost of running a new water service from the curb stop to your house will be your responsibility. If you connect now, then the grant funds for this project will cover your new water service directly in to your house and there will be no cost to you for the connection.
